

HAIR STYLES — *Always away from the face, always off the neck, always beautiful!* *Finger Dance School Trends helps you!*



Pigtail braids and twisted into two buns. A dash of hair spray keeps fly-aways out of the eyes.



a "new wave" look! Brightly colored yarn wrapped around the ponytail. Wear it on the side for a more dramatic look.



Shorter hair can always be away from the face with a hair band or scarf.

TRY THIS!
 ☆ TIP: Braiding your hair while it's wet makes a smoother hairdo. NEVER hairspray wet hair... it dries the hair out.



A colorful yarn holds a short ponytail. Curl the hair under if you like.

TRY THIS!
 ☆ TIP: Cut the tops from knee-high hose to use instead of rubber bands which rip + tear your hair.



French braid into one in the back, pin the ends under. A little hairspray keeps it neat.



Two low braids, wrapped and pinned around the head. These can be french braided next to the scalp for an extra tight hold. Pin ends under to hold secure.



Two high ponytails are always right for shorter hair, especially for thick and wavy hair. Moisten the ends with water and twist around a pencil for extra bounce.



TRY THIS!
 ☆ TIP: After hairspray, sprinkle a little glitter on your hair for pizzazz!



For long hair a high braided pig tail twisted into a bun and pinned on the side. A great style for extra long hair.



A clip holds this ponytail high on the head. To get it extra high, flip the hair over and clip in place while your head is upside down. Great for thin, fine hair!
